Directors are required to actively participate at all scheduled meetings. He/she must sit on at least one committee of the association and attend a minimum of 75% of the scheduled committee meetings.

MEETINGS – Board of Director Meetings – majority of meetings are by conference call. National Directors also sit on their provincial chapter boards.

Flight and accommodation expenses for Board meetings for out-of-town travel are covered. This is a Volunteer position that provides great education in the horse industry with opportunities for networking and of course a great sense of accomplishment.

The election is done by ballot only and ballots are counted and results announced at the AGM.
