BROOD MARES

1. Brood mare, other than CSH, with CSHA breeding approval
2. CSHA Brood Mare, with CSHA breeding approval
3. CSHA Yeld Mare, with CSHA breeding approval

CHAMPION and RESERVE CHAMPION MARES

Open to 1st and 2nd placed from classes 2 & 3 only

FOAL OF 2019

4. Filly, Colt / Gelding

YEARLING – Foaled in 2018

5. Yearling Filly, Colt / Gelding

JUNIOR CHAMPION AND RESERVE JUNIOR CHAMPION

Open to 1st & 2nd placed in classes 4 & 5

TWO YEAR OLD – Foaled in 2017

6. Two Year Old Filly, Colt / Gelding

THREE YEAR OLD – Foaled in 2016

7. Three Year Old Filly, Colt / Gelding

SENIOR CHAMPION AND RESERVE SENIOR CHAMPION

Open to 1st & 2nd placed in classes 6 & 7

STALLION (open to 2019 licensed & approved stallions)

8. CSH Stallion three years of age or over
9. Non CSH Stallions three years of age or over

GRAND CHAMPION C.S.H.A.

Open to all Champions and Reserve Champions and winner of Class 8

PROGENY OF DAM / GET OF SIRE – all entries must have been shown in a class earlier in the day

10. Progeny of Dam – two or three animals of any age, the progeny of one dam.
11. Get of Sire – two or three animals of any age, the get of one sire.

JUNIOR/NOVICE HANDLERS - NO ENTRY FEE

No stallions or colts except weanlings may be shown. Class will be judged on presentation of the animal, neatness and appearance of the handler and overall condition of the animal. Conformation will not be the determining factor, but may count 15%. **Juniors must wear approved helmets.** If less than three (3) entries, classes may be combined.

12. Junior Handler Open to junior handlers up to their 19th birthday. The animal may be owned or borrowed.

13. Novice Handler Open to novice handlers in their first three years of showing on the line. The animal may be owned or borrowed.

UNDER SADDLE CLASSES

14. Three Year Old Under Saddle – Dressage Suitability
15. Three Year Old Under Saddle – Hunter Suitability

CANADIAN SPORT PONY CLASSES- NEW IN 2019!

Open to registered Canadian Sport Ponies only.

Junior CSP

P1. Open to registered CSP Foals or Yearlings, Filly/Colt/Gelding.

Senior CSP

P2. Open to registered Two and Three Year Olds, Filly/Colt/Gelding

SportPony StarSearch Qualifier
CLASSES in the Main Ring – not before 1:00 p.m.

The **SPORTPONY STARSEARCH** winner will be awarded the perpetual **MORTON SPORTPONY CHALLENGE CUP** and a silver keeper plate. Sponsors, **DENWORTH EQUINE MANAGEMENT** (Sherri Whitworth-Denouden and Jeremy Denouden) award \$1000.00 in prize money to the StarSearch Champion at the 2019 Royal Winter Fair.

Requirements for Showing

- Open to any pony that meets the sport pony criteria – hunter, jumper, driving, eventing, etc.
- The first place in each of the 6 in-hand classes at the qualifying shows are eligible to enter to qualify for the SPORTPONY STARSEARCH CHALLENGE CUP, held at the Royal Winter Fair in November 2019.
- Both under saddle class winners also qualify for each respective class.
- Ponies MUST measure 14.2 hands or under. Passports and registration are not necessary to participate. General EC rules for sport horses will apply.
- Adults CAN ride a pony. Stallions may NOT be handled or ridden by children at the Royal Winter Fair but may be, at the qualifying show's discretion.
- If the first place pony has already qualified at a previous show in 2019, then the second place pony becomes the qualifier. Once qualified, a pony may still show at any of the qualifying shows. A list of shows can be viewed at www.royalfair.org.

- A. Foal of current year
- B. Yearling colt, filly or gelding
- C. Two year old colt, filly or gelding
- Junior Champion & Reserve** – open to 1st and 2nd place of classes 1, 2 and 3)
- D. Three years and over mare
- E. Three years and over gelding
- F. Three years and over stallion
- Senior Champion & Reserve** – open to 1st and 2nd place of classes 4, 5 and 6)
- Grand Champion** – open to Junior & Senior Champions & Reserve Champions

- G. Hunter suitability under saddle – open to 3 years & over mare, gelding or stallion
- H. Dressage suitability under saddle – open to 3 years & over mare, gelding or stallion

***Ponies that are registered Canadian Sport Ponies may use the placing that they attain within their class at CSHA sanctioned shows towards CSHA year-end awards.
