*To qualify to compete at the 2023 Royal Sportpony Starsearch a pony must compete and qualify at a listed 2023 qualifier show.

*The first place in each of the six in hand classes qualify for the SPORTPONY STARSEARCH CHALLENGE CUP, held at the Royal Winter Fair in November 2023.

*Both under saddle classes also qualify for each respective class. Ponies MUST measure 14.2 hands or under. Passport and registration are not necessary to participate, nor must the pony be a registered Sportpony. All Sportpony type ponies are eligible to enter qualifying shows if they meet that shows' rules.

*Adults CAN ride a pony. Stallions may NOT be handled or ridden by a junior at this show and Royal Winter Fair

*If the first-place pony has already qualified at a previous show in 2023 then the second-place pony becomes the qualifier. Once qualified a pony may still show at any of the qualifying shows but may only qualify once in 2023.

*To compete in the 2023 Sportpony Finals at the Royal an entry MUST be made prior to the closing date and accepted by the Royal entry department. See www.royalfair.org for entry forms, closing dates, rules & regulations.

*Ponies qualifying after the Royal closing dates **MUST** submit a completed Royal entry form **BEFORE** the Royal entry closing date of **Sept 26th, 2023**. If these entries are not qualified at the late shows the entry will be returned and no entry money will be charged.

****ALL PONIES MUST BE ENTERED BY THE ROYAL SPORTPONY CLOSING DATE.****

Ashland Show Rules

1. Follow the ring steward's directions. Please be prepared to enter the ring **at the walk** when your class is called.
2. Dress neatly and conservatively (absolutely no jeans or tracksuits).
3. Footwear: dark running shoes or flat soled shoes are best.
4. A short crop (30 inches in length max.) is allowed in the ring.
5. Speak to the judge only when spoken to.
6. No toys, lighters, clickers, puffers etc., are allowed in the ring.
7. Only one person can handle a horse throughout an entire class. For example, one person cannot jog the horse and another present it to the judge during the same class.
8. Always keep an eye on the judging, as horses can get loose or kick out when jogging.
9. Unruly horses may be excused from the ring at the request of the judge or ring steward.
10. Drug testing can be requested of any horse in any class.
11. Please always show respect for others in the ring.
12. Juniors 18 years and under must wear an ASTM/SEI-approved equestrian safety helmet.
13. Please help us keep up CSHA standards by bringing your horses out well mannered, braided, and impeccably turned out. Clean well-fitted leather halters for foals and bridles for yearlings and up.
